- C. Highway and Roads
 - a. Swamp, Brandy Creek, Lakeshore, Neitzke Class B Roads signs, No through Trucks Brandy Creek. This is a preemptive measure. Neitzke Road/Hwy 45 is a dangerous intersection. Lakeshore is built on sand. Town Board is looking at the preservation of the road. Reinke road, can it be made a dead end. Fuel trucks are using roads that are not built for them. Are garbage trucks allowed? Yes, they are exempt. Fuel and feed trucks are exempt. Vote Pete Y, Dave abstains, Lynn Y. passed 2-0
 - b. PASER rating needs to be recorded in WISLR by December 15th.
- D. CAWS looking at subsidy to keep open. Approx. \$25k in savings account. Larrabee looking at withdrawing; discussion of raising the fee to \$4 to bag; When we go to curbside, we will get a contracted rate for the Town. Grant money obligates you to recycle. If City and Larrabee pull out at the same time the CAWS site would be dismantled.
